



## Adaptive Physical Education Teacher

### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

The Adaptive Physical Education Teacher, under the supervision of the Director of Special Education, participates as a member of the instructional staff in planning for teaching, motivating students, developing classroom climate, managing the classroom, interacting with pupils and evaluating pupils.

1. Plans the long and short range objectives for assigned courses
2. Develops lesson plans with the appropriate TEKS
3. Establishes goals and objectives for individual pupils in terms of ability
4. Evaluates and provides feedback on pupil performance continuously by utilizing a variety of sources to insure mastery
5. of the TEKS
6. Maintains accurate student accounting records and other reports in compliance with local and state requirements
7. Plans for and engages in professional development
8. Conducts physical education classes for students in accordance with ARD Committee recommendations
9. Conducts assessments and determines eligibility for Adapted PE services
10. Establishes goals and objectives for students in the APE program
11. Serves as a consultant to the regular physical education teachers on all district campuses
12. Advises the Admission, Review, and Dismissal Committee regarding student's needs for adaptive PE services
13. Establishes goals and objectives for students in the APE program
14. Coordinates Special Olympic activities for the District
15. Performs other duties as assigned

### **MENTAL DEMANDS**
