JOB DESCRIPTION

The Choir Director, under the supervision of the Principal, shall direct the instructional program for all choir students and coordinate campus choir activities.

EDUCATIONAL AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's Degree
- Current Texas Teacher Certificate – All Level or Secondary Music education
- Minimum of three (3) years of public school music teaching experience preferred

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provides instruction in the choir program
2. Coordinates the instructional process for choir students in concerts, choir, and music appreciation classes
3. Maintains accurate choir inventory, budget, maintenance, and general operation of all activities
4. Supports all district policies regarding the welfare and education of students
5. Actively coordinates campus choir activities with campus programs, staff, and community
6. Actively prepares students for quality participation in UIL/TMEA sponsored events
7. Actively participates in the professional development of personal teaching competencies
8. Actively participates in professional organizations which foster and support music education
9. Performs other duties as assigned

MENTAL DEMANDS

Ability to communicate effectively (verbal and written), concentrate, interpret policies and procedures, reason, read, understand verbal instructions, analyze, differentiate, coordinate, compile, instruct, and maintain emotional control.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Ability to lift and/or carry moderate weight (15-44 pounds), sit, stand, walk, climb stairs or ladder, reach, repetitive hand motions, hear, speak, some travel within the District and outside the district/county, may experience prolonged and irregular work hours, and work with frequent interruptions.
