The Judson ISD is offering Summer School courses for middle and high school students. All courses will be held at **Judson High School Gray Campus**. Middle school courses will be offered for remediation only.

If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, a full refund will be given. After the first day of classes, no refunds will be given. Please allow approximately two to four weeks for the processing of refund checks.

REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Course Enrollment

In order for a class to be offered, a minimum of 15 students must be enrolled in the course.

Student Dress & Grooming Code

A copy of the dress code will be issued to each student at the time of registration. It is the responsibility of the parents and the students to ensure that acceptable attire is worn each day of school. Students will be subject to disciplinary action--including removal from summer school and loss of credit--if dress and grooming code violations occur.

Attendance/Tardy Policy

Due to the short length of class sessions, as well as the academic intensity of the summer school program, prompt and consistent attendance is required. Students who are persistently tardy to class may be dropped from summer school without course credit or refund of tuition.

If a student exceeds two excused or unexcused absences, he/she risks loss of credit without refund. Excused absences may include illness (with a doctor's note) and death in the family. Vacations or school activities will **NOT** be considered excused absences. Attendance on the final day of each summer session is **mandatory**.

Student Conduct

The student code of conduct for Judson ISD will be issued at registration. All students will be required to follow the student code of conduct during summer school. If a student is suspended or expelled for any reason, course credit will **NOT** be issued and tuition will **NOT** be refunded.

Grade Classification

Grade classification will be based on the student's grade level during the 2008-2009 school year.
