Child Nutrition Driver/Server– Child Nutrition Department

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Child Nutrition Driver/Server under the direct supervision of the Child Nutrition Director, Child Nutrition Director, or Assistant Director, delivers food to elementary cafeterias and serves lunch. This person must maintain a high standard of quality in food delivery, sanitation, and safety practices.

EDUCATIONAL / CERTIFICATION / EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Experience in Child Nutrition (1 year preferred)
- Valid Texas Driver's license
- Must be able to operate a motor vehicle
- Clean and neat in appearance
- Driving record acceptable to Judson ISD insurance carrier

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to pass Human Performance Exam (HPE)

KNOWLEDGE / SKILLS / ABILITIES:

- Ability to understand safety instructions
- Ability to be punctual and dependable
- Must be able to understand instructions and communicate in basic English

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Is responsible for loading food carts onto delivery truck.
2. Delivers food to elementary cafeterias as assigned.
3. Serves food to the campus students at the last delivery run.
4. Returns to each school and pick up carts and returns to the Central Kitchen.
5. Is responsible for unloading truck.
6. Assists with unloading carts.
7. Is responsible for cleaning carts.
8. Assists in washing pots and pans at the Central Kitchen.
9. Maintains personal appearance and hygiene.
10. Follows safety and sanitation rules and regulations.
11. Maintains a clean and organized delivery truck.
12. Completes daily truck inspection.
13. The foregoing statements describe the general purpose and responsibilities assigned to this job and are not an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties, and skills required.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

MENTAL DEMANDS: Ability to communicate (verbally and written), understand verbal instructions, read, and maintain emotional control under stress.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Must be able to lift/carry heavy weight (15-44 pounds), stand, sit, walk, climb, balance, stoop, pull, push, reach, hear, repetitive hand motions, and drive a Child Nutrition truck/van. Must be able to work inside and outside in temperature/humidity extremes, noise, slippery surfaces, chemical exposure (asbestos, fumes, vapors, gases, dusts, smoke, etc.), works around moving objects or vehicles and works around machines with moving parts.
