JOB DESCRIPTION

The Assistant Band Director, under the supervision of the Principal and the Head Band Director, shall assist in directing the instructional program for all band students and assist in the coordinating of campus band activities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provides instruction in the band program
2. Coordinates the instructional process for band students in concert/marching/jazz, theory, appreciation/history classes
3. Maintains accurate band inventory, budget, maintenance, and general operation of all activities
4. Supports all district policies regarding the welfare and education of students
5. Actively coordinates the efforts of the band booster organization
6. Actively coordinates campus band activities with campus programs, staff, and community
7. Actively prepares students for quality participation in UIL/TMEA sponsored events
8. Actively participates in the professional development of personal teaching competencies
9. Actively participates in professional organizations which foster and support music education
10. Performs other duties as assigned

MENTAL DEMANDS

Ability to communicate effectively (verbal and written), concentrate, interpret policies and procedures, reason, read, understand verbal instructions, analyze, differentiate, coordinate, compile, instruct, and maintain emotional control.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Ability to lift and/or carry moderate weight (15-44 pounds), sit, reach, repetitive hand motions, hear, speak, travel frequently within the District and occasionally outside the district/county, may experience prolonged and irregular work hours, and work with frequent interruptions.
