

Summer School Student Success Initiative

The Student Success Initiative (SSI), created by the Texas Legislature, is designed to ensure that students in grades 5 and 8 receive instructional support to succeed in reading and mathematics.

Students in grades 5 and 8 have three opportunities to pass the reading and mathematics TAKS, TAKS Accommodated, or TAKS-Modified assessments—two during the spring and one during the summer. All 5th and 8th grade students must pass both tests in order to move on to the next grade level.

The instruction for students in grades 5 and 8 who attend the SSI summer school program, is based on the individual needs of the student, as outlined by the home campus Grade Placement Committee (GPC) or the Admission, Review, Dismissal (ARD) committee.

Decisions for promotion or retention will be made based on the results of the summer TAKS test. Each student's home campus principal will notify the parents of final testing results after July 15, 2010.



Student Dress & Grooming Code

It is the responsibility of the parents and the students to ensure that acceptable attire is worn each day of school. Students will be subject to disciplinary action if dress and grooming code violations occur.

Attendance/ Tardy Policy

Due to the short length of class sessions, as well as the academic intensity of the summer school program, prompt and consistent attendance is required.

Student Conduct

All students will be required to follow the student code of conduct during summer school.

Transportation

The district will provide transportation to and from each summer school campus. Elementary students will be picked up at their designated neighborhood stop. Middle School students will be picked up and returned to their home school at the end of each day.



Food Service

Free breakfast and lunch will be served daily.
