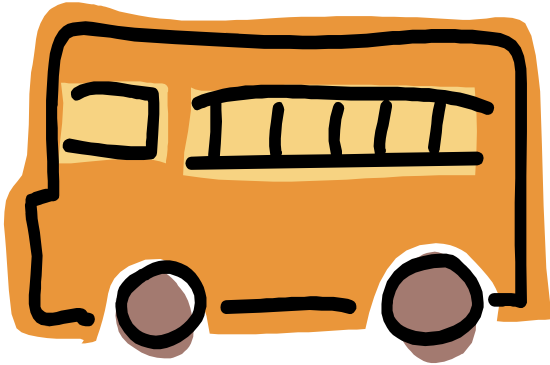

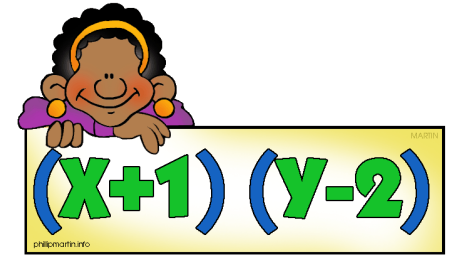

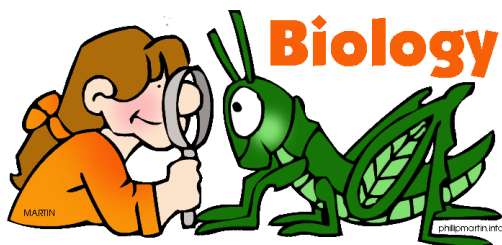


What is the Algebra I & Biology I End of Course (EOC) Camp?

The purpose of the Algebra I & Biology I End of Course (EOC) prep camp is to provide students who attend Judson, Woodlake, Metzger, and Kirby Middle Schools with the opportunity to receive an exciting jump start for their freshman year of math and science. Data shows that 80% of students who completed the camp passed the Algebra I EOC and 100% passed the Biology EOC on their first attempt.

Students will be given the chance to experience *hands on, high-tech learning* to introduce specific concepts necessary for successful entry into their high school experience.

This camp is provided at no cost to the student.

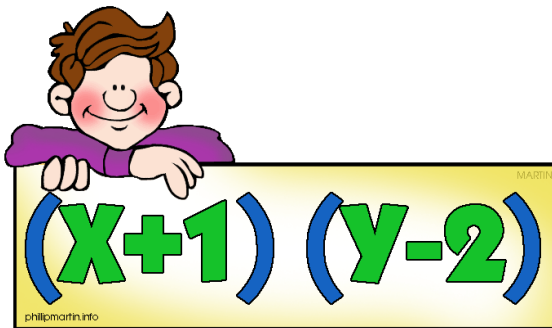


What is the End of Course Exam (EOC)?

Students will take a STAAR EOC Exam in Biology and Algebra at the end of their freshman year to show mastery.

Students will be required to pass the EOC exams to receive a high school diploma.

3 hours of instruction in Algebra I and 3 hours of instruction in Biology I.
