What is the Algebra I & Biology I End of Course (EOC) Camp?

The purpose of the Algebra I & Biology I End of Course (EOC) prep camp is to provide students with the opportunity to receive an exciting jump start for their freshman year of math and science. Data shows that 84% of students who completed the camp passed the Algebra I EOC and 97% passed the Biology EOC on their first attempt.

Students will be given the chance to experience *hands on, high-tech learning* to introduce specific concepts necessary for successful entry into their high school experience.

What is the End of Course Exam (EOC)?

STAAR is an assessment program designed to measure the extent to which students have learned and are able to apply the knowledge and skills defined in the state-mandated curriculum standards, the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS).

Students will take a STAAR EOC Exam in Biology and Algebra at the end of their freshman year.

Students will be required to pass the EOC exams to receive a high school diploma.

Classes will be held

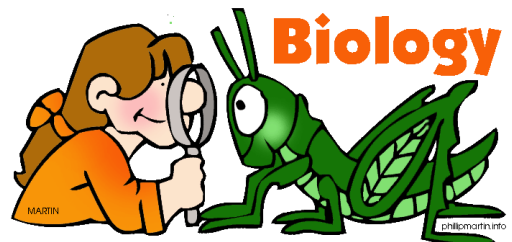
Monday– Thursday
