



2019 Student Success Initiative (SSI) Summer School Program

State Law Requirements

The Student Success Initiative (SSI) was created by the Texas Legislature to ensure that all students receive the instruction and support they need to be academically successful in mathematics and reading. Under the SSI grade advancement requirements, students are required to pass the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®) grade 5 mathematics and reading tests to be promoted to sixth grade. Students are required to pass the STAAR grade 8 mathematics and reading tests to be promoted to ninth grade.

In addition to the SSI grade advancement requirements, state law mandates that high school students must not only meet all course requirements but also pass the STAAR end-of-course assessments in Algebra I, English I, English II, Biology, and U.S. History to receive a diploma from a Texas public high school.

General Information

Students who do not pass the 2nd administration of STAAR in math and/or reading will receive required accelerated instruction through the SSI Summer Program. The home campus will determine and provide the SSI teacher with specific academic information so that students can be given the best instruction through carefully designed lessons. Our goal is to help students to improve and show progress on the third administration of STAAR as well as to equip them with the tools needed to be successful in math and reading.

Once the home campus receives test results, families will be contacted to schedule a Grade Placement Committee (GPC) meeting to review student data and STAAR scores. Decisions on grade promotion or retention will be made during this meeting. For questions regarding the GPC, please contact your student's home campus.
