

Invention Project Registration

Invention Project is a program available at Title I Middle School campuses in the District. This one week summer camp explores the engineering process through trial and error in a fun and exciting way. Students work through ten modules in the week, each one tackles a different aspect of design – creation, modification, sales, and usability. Students build robotic dogs, the house of the future, and other engaging activities.

To attend the student needs to be in attendance at one of the following campuses:

Woodlake Hills MS, Kirby MS, Metzger MS, or Judson MS / JSTEM. Each campus will be given 25 spots for students to attend the Invention Project on June 10th – 13th. The primary focus is 7th graders, but we will gladly accept current 6th – 8th grade students.

Teachers at these campuses will be given flyers to go home with the students. We will do our best to accommodate all students who apply, but must limit total enrollment at each camp.

i.e. If we don't get 25 students from Judson MS / JSTEM, and we have more than 25 from Kirby, we will just bring more students over from Kirby until we reach capacity.

Busses will be available to the students who are in need to attend the camp if parents cannot provide transport.

Flyers will be sent to the campuses for the students as soon as the teachers and coordinators are hired.
