What is Writing for Science

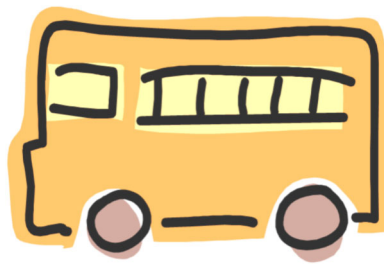
Writing for Science is an opportunity for our Grade 8 students to explore interesting topics in Science and then write about their learning using Claims, Evidence, and Reasoning.
