Judson ISD Invests In 1-To-1 Devices For Student Remote Learning

Judson ISD has announced that it will invest \$ 3.75 million in its online learning program for a 1-to-1 device to student initiative. The announcement was made at a special board meeting of the Judson ISD Board of Trustees July 7, 2020 as district administrators presented the plan for instructional delivery to all students. This will involve a device for each student PreK through grade 12 that is involved in the virtual or the blended models of instruction. Judson ISD's current enrollment is close to 23,000 students.

JISD knows that for online learning to be effective, the 1-to-1 device to student plan is the best choice to make. While lender devices were issued by the District in a one per family fashion back in the spring to keep students at pace with foundation learning, individual devices for each student will allow for the rate of learning that is necessary during the school year.
