Alamo Promise Launch Coming To Judson and Wagner

Judson High School and Wagner High School will be two of the very first high school campuses in San Antonio to host the launching of the college tuition initiative called Alamo Promise. The program ensures a free tuition plan for 60 semester credit hours to any Alamo College campus.

Alamo Colleges starts its recruitment in Judson ISD at **Judson High School on October 2, 2019 at a 2 p.m. rally in the Performing Arts Center next to the high school. That will be followed by a different ceremony at Wagner High School's gymnasium on October 9, 2019 at 9 a.m.** These events will introduce this incredible opportunity to students at each school and outline the benefits and ways to find out more information to participate.

Alamo Promise is set to serve as a last-dollar scholarship covering the remaining cost of tuition after students exhaust federal financial aid. 25 local high schools were selected as initial launch campuses this fall to increase the overall rate of attendance at local community colleges. The recruiting program will expand over the next several years to other high schools and over the next five years expect some 19,000 more students to enroll at Alamo College campuses because of this effort.

Alamo Colleges has five campuses in the San Antonio area. They include San Antonio College, St. Phillips College, Northwest Vista College, Northeast Lakeview College, and Palo Alto College.
