SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Information regarding MOY Reading and Math data in relation to the superintendent goals was presented by Dr. Kristin Saunders (Chief of Staff) and Dr. Mary Duhart-Toppen (Assistant Superintendent of C&I)

Superintendent Goals

- 1. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 65% by June 2027.
- 2. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 31% to 54% by June 2027.
- 3. The percentage of 7th grade students that score at Approaches grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 37% to 60% by June 2027.

Constraint 5: Students with Disabilities Family Experience:

Constraint Progress Measure 5.a: The Superintendent shall examine the enrollment data for special programs and report on it annually to ensure equitable access and appropriate campus supports exist for all students.
