Dear Judson ISD Community:

Thank you for your patience as we navigate a new experience of learning at home. Even though school is on pause, learning will continue, and our district is committed to embracing endless opportunities for at-home learning experiences. As we adjust to distance learning, our initial focus is on strengthening the foundational skills and build retention of previously learned skills. Of great importance is to also build a love for daily reading and sharing the learning with parents and family. As students work from home, we ask that they hold on to their assignments until school resumes. During the school pause, learning will continue but students will not receive any new grades for learning that occurs while the district is closed. All assignment packets and work will be collected once school resumes.

Our Curriculum and Instruction Department created instructional choice boards that have been shared with all elementary and middle school principals. These choice boards allow for students to select activities they can connect with to personalize their instruction. These boards are also posted online, and can be accessed by anyone who visits our district website at <https://www.judsonisd.org/Domain/93>. In addition for those who do not have online access, hard copies of instructional packets can be picked up at all elementary and middle school campuses on Wednesday, March 25, 2020 from 9 am until 11 am. We understand that nothing can replace the quality instruction provided by our teachers in the classroom, but please remember that teachers will continue to proactively communicate with students and families to support learning and provide feedback as requested.

For high school students, teachers have been using Google Classroom to conduct digital learning as most high school students were already familiar with this specific learning platform.

We anticipate school closure until April 3<sup>rd</sup>, yet we have provided instructional packets for 8 weeks of instruction to be prepared should the COVID-19 pandemic continue.
