Judson ISD Cancels In-Person Graduations After County Mandate

Due to the recent COVID-19 mandates by the state and the county, Judson ISD will cancel all in-person graduation ceremonies for our high schools. Governor Greg Abbott signed an executive order allowing local officials to enact the crowd restrictions. San Antonio has experienced a high number of COVID-19 cases recently and because of this, Bexar County Judge Nelson Wolf has mandated no gatherings of more than 100 people.

Due to this mandate and for the protection of our community we are canceling all of the JISD Graduations. All high school campuses will be making arrangements to deliver the diplomas and the covers to the students. JISD will not be considering any graduations in July or December.

Those graduation ceremonies were to involve the JISD's five high schools (Judson, Wagner, Veterans Memorial, Judson Early College Academy, and Judson Learning Academy) and were set for June 29, 30, and July 1, 2020 at Rutledge Stadium.
