**Judson ISD & City of Converse Partner to honor the fallen heroes of 9/11**

The Judson ISD Police Department in partnership with City of Converse Police and Fire Department will gather to honor the fallen heroes of September 11, 2001 with a memorial stair climb.

The program will begin with a brief remembrance ceremony then the participants will climb several sets of stairs over an hour and a half, stopping along the way to commemorate specific times such as; when each building collapsed, and the time the pentagon was struck and the time that flight 93 crashed.

Due to COVID-19 the event will be closed to the public but participation will be managed with special precautions taken into consideration such as a staggered start and spaced throughout the stadium. The event will be live streamed on the city of converse social media pages and shared via Judson ISD social media pages (handles can be found below).
