**Free COVID Vaccine Clinic for Elementary Students at Judson ISD**

Judson ISD has partnered with HEB Pharmacy to offer a free COVID Vaccine Clinic for elementary students who are 5 years old and older. Each Judson ISD elementary campus will host their own clinic where students will receive the Pfizer vaccine. This free opportunity is optional and requires parental consent. The clinics for the first dose will begin on Tuesday, November 30 and continue until December 10.

We are excited to be able to bring this opportunity to our students. Many of our families have been eager for the district to provide a way for students to receive vaccinations but some students may not be so eager to receive a shot. Parents can choose to be with their child during the vaccination, however, parents who are not able to be there can be assured that their child will be accompanied by their teacher, and the school nurse will be on site as well to make sure there is a level of familiarity and comfort for them. The plan is to provide a comfortable environment and positive experience for our young children if parents choose to participate in this vaccine clinic.

The clinic for the second dose and a clinic for middle school students will be scheduled after the Christmas Holiday Break, around January 10<sup>th</sup>.
