JISD Cuts Ribbon On 20th Elementary in Midyear Ceremony

It's been open to students for several weeks, but Judson ISD will formally cut the ribbon on its 20 elementary school on Wednesday, March 27, 2019 at 9:30 am. Wortham Oaks Elementary School opened to students on February 4, 2019 to approximately 250 students after spending the first half of the year sharing the Rolling Oaks Elementary campus until the new school was finished

Wortham Oaks Elementary School Principal Yvonne Munoz will be hosting the ceremony that will include the student choir singing the school song publicly for the first time. The event will also include remarks from JISD Superintendent Dr. Jeanette Ball and personal insights from several Wortham students about what the school means to them.

As the leader at Wortham Oaks, Ms. Munoz has significant experience with building a quality school. She left her position as the principal at Crestview Elementary, a National Blue Ribbon School, to take on this new challenge.

The Wortham Oaks campus was scheduled to open at the beginning of the spring semester, but breaking through extensive bedrock for excavation and one of the wettest falls on record delayed the opening for about a month. Despite those challenges, the school opened up within budget and ready to go for students.
