ESSER I Summary

- Enacted by the CARES Act in March 2020
- \$1.3 Billion package encompasses federal funds to prevent, prepare for and respond to the Coronavirus
- Judson ISD received last fall \$4,195,940
- Primary focuses: Salaries, Technology, Utilities, Equitable Services with Private Non-Profit Schools
- End date September 30, 2022

ESSER II Summary

- Authorized by the CRRSA Act in December 2020
- \$5.5 Billion bundle similar to CARES addressing learning loss among at-risk populations, social/emotional support, technology, air quality
- Waiting for guidance from TEA on amount allocated, grant release date, and specifics of the grant
- End date September 30, 2023

ESSER III Summary

- Enacted by the ARPA in March 2021
- \$12.4 Billion plan
- At least 20% must be used on addressing learning loss such as summer learning/enrichment, after school or extended year programming. Focus support on High Poverty Schools.
- Can address academic, social and emotional student needs, technology support
- Waiting for guidance from TEA on amount allocated, grant release date, and specifics of the grant
- End date September 20, 2024
