

Classroom Management Plan

CHAMPS is a system of expectations that works with any set of rules, rewards, or consequences that you are already implementing. It can even be used if your school has a specific classroom management program in place.

The *CHAMPS* acronym stands for:

*C**onversation*: Can students talk to each other during this activity? What level will my voice be at when I am working?

*H**elp*: How do students get the teacher's attention and their questions answered?

*A**ctivity*: What is the task/objective? What is the end product? Is it group work or independent work?

*M**ovement*: Can students move about during this activity? Where in the classroom will I be working?

*P**articipation*: How do students show they are fully participating? What does work behavior look/sound like?

*S**uccess*: When students meet *CHAMPS* expectations and follow direction's they will be successful learners!!!
