Proclamation

October - Dyslexia Awareness Month

- WHEREAS, Judson Independent School District's Board of Trustees joins the International Dyslexia Association in recognizing October as Dyslexia Awareness Month worldwide; and
- WHEREAS, Judson ISD is committed to equal educational opportunities by identifying obstacles to educational advancement and success and endeavoring to remove those obstacles; and
- WHEREAS, literacy is a critical skill needed for educational success and research shows students who read on grade level by third grade vastly outperform their peers who did not throughout their educational careers; and
- WHEREAS, dyslexia affects all segments of society, regardless of race, income, educational background, or ability; and
- WHEREAS, research conducted by the National Institute of Health indicated that up to one in five individuals may struggle with Dyslexia and related learning disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, dyslexia is a specific learning disability that is neurological in origin characterized by difficulties with accurate and/or fluent word recognition and by poor spelling and decoding abilities; and
- WHEREAS, secondary consequences may include problems in reading comprehension and reduced reading experience that can impede growth of vocabulary and background knowledge; and

WHEREAS, those afflicted must overcome challenges in school, work, and personal growth, this learning difference can be made easier to overcome through early identification and appropriate educational programming; and

WHEREAS, Judson ISD encourages our families to join in supporting individuals and families affected by dyslexia and to recognize our Judson Dyslexia Therapists for their ongoing efforts to provide vital support and resources for our students with dyslexia to attain proficient literacy skills and achieve lifelong success.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Renee Paschall, as by virtue of the authority vested in me as School Board President of the Judson Independent School District Board of Trustees, do hereby proclaim October as Dyslexia Awareness Month in the Judson Independent School District, and encourage all to spread awareness of dyslexia and the resources available to our Judson ISD students and families.
