

ELYAS PEREZ ACCEPTED INTO NAVY SEALS TRAINING

In the Fall of 2019, Elyas Perez told himself that he would be a Navy SEAL.

He didn't know what he would be required to do or what would be expected of him. Over the next four years, the path to becoming a SEAL took left and right turns, ups and downs, roadblocks and hurdles.

But that didn't detour Perez because he knew he would be a Navy SEAL.

On November 30, HM1 (FMF) Reuben Castro and his team from the <u>Navy Warrior Challenge</u>

<u>Program</u> surprised Perez with his acceptance into the Navy SEAL Basic Underwater

Demolition/SEAL Training at Coronado Beach, California.

"This is extremely rare, especially for a high schooler," Castro said. "He goes up against candidates throughout the nation. We take his numbers, send them to headquarters, and they determine, based on his skills, if he's ready for this training."

On June 4, four days after graduation, Perez will ship out to California to begin his training.






HOPKINS ELEMENTARY WINS BACK-TO-BACK IPLAY SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIPS




HOLIDAY CARDS DESIGNED BY OUR STUDENTS


