JUDSON ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT ADOPTING A JISD FAMILY



FIVE STUDENTS EARN SCHOLARSHIPS FROM VALERO ALAMOBOWL

For its 31st annual game, the Valero Alamo Bowl awarded \$1.2 million split between 165 San Antonio high school and college students via two programs.

This amount was expected to be the largest local scholarship total in Valero Alamo Bowl history and #1 among all bowl games. On December 13, at the H-E-B Scholarship Awards Luncheon at Security Service Event Center, 94 high school winners representing 67 San Antonio area public and private schools shared in \$690,000 in Valero Alamo Bowl Student-Athlete scholarships.

The scholarships were awarded based on academic achievement, teacher recommendations, involvement in extracurricular activities, and varsity sports as well as honors received and a personal narrative.

The Bowl's college program is called the Valero Alamo Bowl Community Partners scholarship and is funded by the Valero Alamo Bowl and matching programs at all six of San Antonio's four-year universities. Last August, 71 deserving college students were chosen to share \$510,000 in awards.

Inclusive of this year's totals, 1,747 scholarship winners have split \$10.8 million in awards from the Valero Alamo Bowl.
