Nevertheless, every Tuesday afternoon at Judson Middle School, Mr. Henry Griffith, Mr. Thomas Holstein, and Mr. Korie Culpepper provide that sense of belonging - through skateboarding.

"I do this because I wasn't connected when I was a kid," Holstein said. "I wanted a way to connect kids who aren't involved in traditional team sports. We need to help kids, connect them, and give them a reason to come to school."

They host the weekly skate club on Tuesdays, after school, utilizing the massive courtyard the school surrounds. Seeing the largest group they've had all year on the day of this feature, students were skating around the courtyard, hanging out, laughing, teaching each other tricks, and creating that sense of belonging.

"It's a judgment-free zone," Holstein said. "We've had book study. We watch videos [about skateboarding]. We tackle social-emotional health. We want kids to understand that every person belongs, every person can be a part of something, and every person matters. For me, skateboarding did that."
