But in 1995, teacher salaries weren't nearly as high as today's. With three small children in school and daycare, she couldn't go back to school to be a guidance counselor.

Then, Columbine happened, which changed education forever.

At that moment, she knew she wanted to be a counselor - she wanted to do more to help students.

When the district says One Home, One Family, Mrs. Kellye Jackson is the epitome of that.
