






JUDSON ISD NEW PRINCIPAL ONBOARDING


Judson ISD Give Back Night at the San Antonio Spurs Game! Go Spurs Go!

WORK ON A.I. PROJECTS DURING THE SUMMER

Over the summer, two Wagner High School alumni - Ian Fernandes and Joseph Wilson - participated in internships with Microsoft and Amazon. Fernandes was part of the team at Microsoft, working with artificial intelligence to develop a code-autocompletion tool for Microsoft cloud resource policies. Wilson worked on a team at Amazon, working to create a tool to pull data to better artificial intelligence.

"I'm really thankful to be working on this project. There's so much untapped potential with artificial intelligence. Now, companies are realizing they can integrate this into their products," Fernandes said.



JUDSON ISD RECEIVED \$254,847 GRANT TO HELP TRAIN 150 STUDENTS AS INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERS

Governor Greg Abbott today announced 42 <u>Jobs and Education for Texans (JET)</u> grants totaling over \$11 million have been awarded by the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) to public junior, state, and technical colleges, school districts, and open-enrollment charter schools across the state. These grants will be used to purchase equipment

necessary to establish or expand career and technical education programs that offer Texas students the opportunity to earn a license, certificate, or post-secondary degree for good-paying, high-demand careers. Within the first year, the new equipment will be used to initially train more than 8,300 students.

JET grants will be used to purchase and install equipment at Judson ISD and the \$254,847 grant will help train 150 students as industrial engineers throughout CTE programs.
