

## Resolution of the Board of Judson ISD & the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Grant Program

**WHEREAS**, The Judson ISD finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Judson ISD, Bexar County, Texas, that the Office of the Governor (OOG) Criminal Justice Grant Program be operated for the 2023-2024 academic year; and
