WHEREAS, the Superintendent has determined that for the safety of students and staff that all instruction will be canceled, and staff will work from home, if possible, while some staff may be asked to physically work on campus; and

WHEREAS the loss of pay for employees that were not allowed to come to work may create a financial hardship.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordered by the Board of Trustees of the Judson Independent School District, in accordance with policy DEA (Local), the Board authorizes payment for employees during the emergency school closure.
