Face to Face Instruction (PK-12)

Judson ISD is proud to offer an option that brings students **back to campus to learn in-person** with their teachers and peers. This option is available for all students in elementary, middle and high school.

- Students will receive in-person instruction on campus Monday thru Friday
- Instruction will be delivered in-person using lessons that have been designed to be both engaging and rigorous while limiting the sharing of classroom supplies and materials
- Local and state guidelines will be strictly followed to ensure the health and safety of students and staff, such as providing sanitizing stations, ensuring proper distancing, and reducing the number of students transitioning in hallways
- All areas of the campus will be sanitized throughout the day in addition to several days scheduled for deep cleaning
- Students will be able to participate in Extracurricular Activities and Clubs; dependent on local guidance and safety measures
- Academic progress (grades) will be determined based on the Judson ISD Grading Handbook
- Attendance will be taken daily

Remote Learning Instruction (PK-12)

Judson ISD is excited to announce an **enhanced virtual learning experience** now called **J-Learning at Home**.

This option is available for all students in elementary, middle and high school.

- Students will receive virtual instruction and engage in lessons at home Monday thru Friday
- Students will be able to check out their own electronic device in addition to learning kits, which would include various resources to support their learning at home
- Instruction will be delivered in a variety of innovative ways such as direct virtual teaching, interactive videos and modules, and the use of our district-wide online learning extension programs
- Virtual tutoring and parent support training will be available
- WiFi will be available at all elementary campus parking lots
- Students will be able to participate virtually in various Extracurricular Activities and Clubs
- Academic progress (grades) will be determined based on the Judson ISD Grading Handbook
- Attendance will be taken daily
- Meals will be available for remote learners

Blended Learning (MS & HS)

This model combines both the Face to Face and Remote learning options described in Option A and B.

- Students who choose the Blended Learning model will be assigned to either Group A or Group B and have staggered schedules

Face to Face or Remote Learning (Judson Early College Academy)

These options were developed in conjunction with Northeast Lakeview College

- 9th & 10th grade students may choose one option:
 - Face to Face (in-person instruction)
 - Remote (virtual instruction)
- 11th & 12th grade students will participate in Remote Learning and receive instruction virtually

JLA

Face to Face or Remote Learning (Judson Learning Academy)

- Students who choose the Face to Face option will receive in-person instruction on campus Monday thru Friday
- Students who choose the Face to Face option will be scheduled to attend either a morning or afternoon session
- Students who choose the Remote Learning option will receive instruction virtually Monday thru Friday
