

Productions (Varsity Theatre Auditions)

Thank you for your interest in Auditioning for Productions Class. This course is a co-curricular class in the Theatre Program, where students compete in acting throughout the year. Students are expected to rehearse after school hours and some Saturdays.

Audition Requirement:

Actor:

- 1 Monologue (Contemporary) or Due to COVID-19, the industry is changing and so you may use 1 minute of voice over work in place of the monologue.)
- 16-32 bars of a song (Musical Number, usually the chorus line)
- 30 seconds of Choreography
 - (Use **CLI Dance Studio** choreography found on youtube. They have a variety of different dance styles to choose from)

Technical Theatre Student (Techie):

- 1 page, double spaced paper on your previous experience as a Techie and what skills you would bring to the class.
- Example of work.
 - Examples include, but are not limited to: Costume Design, Set design, Construction, Sound Design, Film or any creative product (i.e., painting, 3D model, lego castle....)
