



Judson ISD Safe Haven Guidelines for Parents

1. Parents that meet the criteria may be eligible to bring their children to the Judson ISD Safe Haven Program. Students that are eligible must follow all the guidelines set in the Judson ISD Safe Haven Program. Students will be categorized by priority level in an effort to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all.
2. Children will be supervised by a Judson ISD employee, but *there will be no face to face instruction* except for specific students who receive Special Education services through a specialized program.
3. If parents choose to bring their child to school, it is with the understanding that their child may NOT misbehave, must be healthy and adhere to all safety rules.
 - Temperature checks will be done daily at the campus prior to entering the building.
 - Masks must be worn at all times by **all** students.
 - Student must bring their technology device on a daily basis.
 - Student must either qualify for free lunch or bring lunch in a disposable bag or bring money for lunch.
 - Student must be picked up or ride the bus at the end of the school day unless prearrangements have been made with Adventure Club.If any of the above required responsibilities are compromised, parents will have three days to find alternate arrangements.
4. All children, including children under ten years old, will need to wear a mask at all times in the building other than when eating or during a designated time to remove the mask.
5. Children should bring their own instructional and personal materials such as a water bottle, school-assigned learning device, headphones, etc.
6. The child's parent will be required to complete screener prior to coming to school. In addition, temperature checks will be done before entering the school.
7. Children will also be required to practice good hygiene and wash their hands or use hand sanitizer once arriving on the campus and throughout the day.

IMPORTANT: *The decision for space availability must be made in conjunction with campus principal. This decision will be based on the criteria for meeting Safe Haven guidelines and space availability to social distance students.

Health and Hygiene Practices:

1. Students must use hand-sanitizer and/or wash their hands once arriving on campus and throughout the school day. Hand-sanitizer will be made available by campus at entry points and throughout the school.
2. All individuals on campus must wear a face mask once they arrive on school property and while entering the campus.
 - For the purposes of this document, masks include non-medical grade disposable face masks, cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth).
 - Students with special needs receiving Special Education will be given options regarding the face coverings they may wear depending on their medical condition.

Wear Face Coverings Correctly:

- Wash your hands before putting on your face covering.
- Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin.
- Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face.
- Make sure you can breathe easily.
