Last Holiday 5/30 - Memorial Day



Although Memorial Day is viewed by most Americans as the unofficial start of summer and is spent hosting bar- b-ques, watching parades, or traveling, we must never let the true meaning and reason we have Memorial Day be lost or overlooked. Memorial Day was originally known as Decoration Day and was observed on May 30th for over 100 years. With over two dozen places claiming to have originated the day of observance, tracing its true origins has proven to be difficult. What is known is loved ones began decorating the headstones of their fallen soldier during and after the Civil War, although, this is a practice can be traced back to ancient times.

In 1971, Memorial Day became the official name and Congress designated the last Monday in May as the official holiday. 3:00 p.m. local time is designated the National Moment of Remembrance. For one minute, pause to honor those men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice while serving our country.
