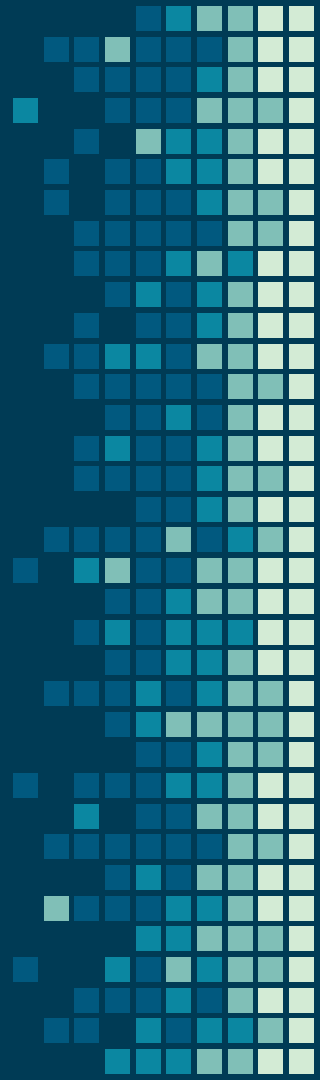

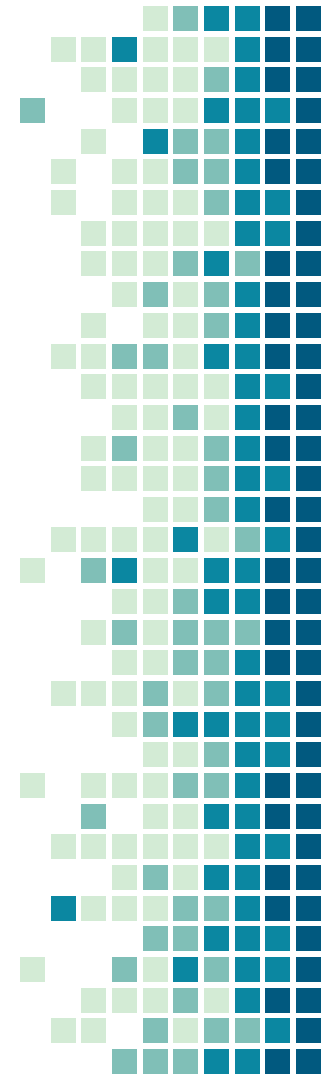
IB Goals

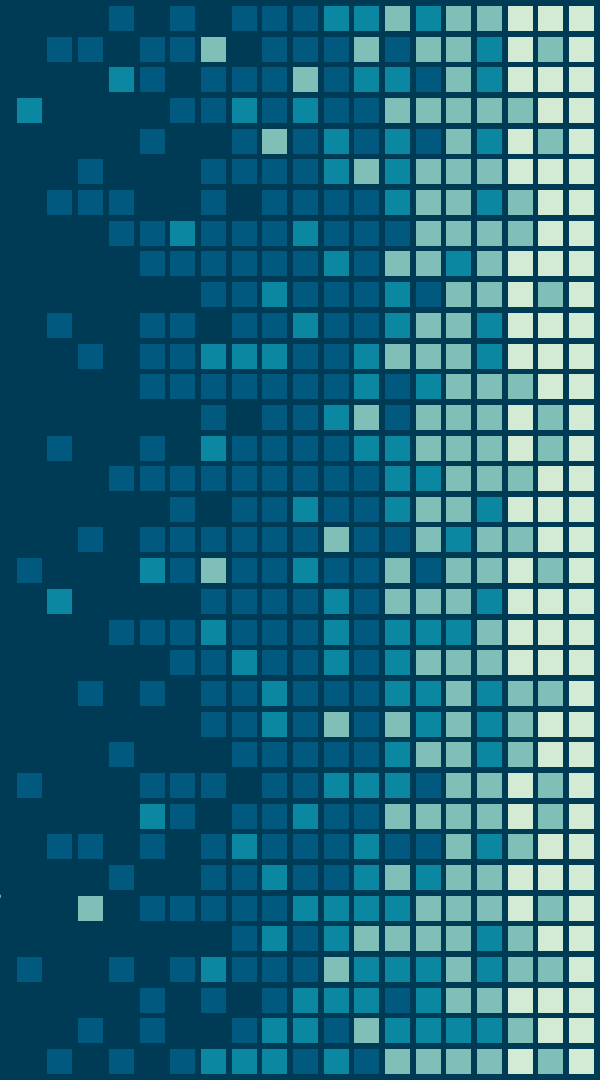

Pre-IB focus

Students are grouped into advanced cohorts within core courses for 9th-10th years:

English 1 and 2 Honors

Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2

Biology, Chemistry, Physics

AP Human Geography or AP World History,
AP US History

Phys Ed, Fine Arts, Spanish 1-2 and electives round out the selections for the first two years.

Research Project on a student selected subject and question.

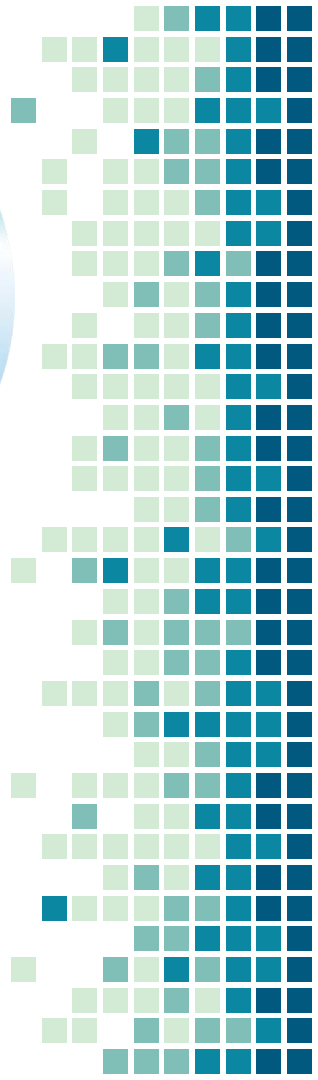
Theory Of Knowledge
