Dear Judson ISD Parents and Community,

As we maintain our focus on campus safety and security, we wanted to inform you that we will continue to practice our Standard Response Protocols through the end of the school year. We want to ensure that all campuses are ready in the event of any emergency situation, including what students and staff would do during a **LOCKDOWN** situation. As we practice our **LOCKDOWN** protocols and procedures, we will **not** be using any weapon/firearm simulation that may startle or scare anyone in the building.

What is a **LOCKDOWN**? **LOCKDOWN** is called when there is a threat or hazard inside the school building. The Lockdown Action demands locking interior doors, moving occupants out of the line of sight of corridor windows, turning off lights to make the room seem unoccupied, and having occupants maintain silence. If students are unable to get behind a locked door, they are trained to self-evacuate.

Practice drills will be scheduled during the school day, but the time of the drill will not be announced. We have created a schedule that will not interrupt the testing environment during the upcoming STAAR state assessment window. You may receive information about the **LOCKDOWN** drill from your campus principal after the drill occurs.
