Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year and we are so excited to have your beautiful, eager children on our campus. ID needed to come to any Judson ISD campus. Due to heavy car traffic at this campus, we must increase safety for all children.

CHANGES: Please remember some very important items as we start the year:

TRAFFIC:

1. **ALL** PreK and Kindergarten students with their brothers/sisters (even if they are in the upper grades) will be dropped and picked up at the front of the building after the buses have left the parking lot. Make sure you park by the curb and do not block the bus lanes. There will be a person directing traffic.
 - a. **You MUST enter the Hartman front parking from the Woodlake Parkway Street area.** No one coming from the back area of Hartman will be allowed to enter this PreK/Kinder drop off area.

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2. **ALL** 1ST, 2ND, 3RD, 4TH, 5TH grade students are dropped and picked up through the back of Hartman (MidCrown Street entrance). *There will not be any PreK or Kinder kids in the back for increased safety measures.*

a. **You MUST approach Hartman from the back side of Hartman (MidCrown Street).**

No one coming from Woodlake Parkway side of Hartman will be allowed to enter the upper grades drop off.

Bell Schedule:

- 6:45am Buses arrive at Hartman Elementary School
- 7:00am First bell rings for students to enter classrooms and eat free breakfast
- 7:20am Breakfast must be put away
- 7:30am Tardy bell and students will be marked as late
- 2:55pm Student pick up
- 3:00pm Walkers are released to the front and back
- 3:15pm Late pickups are sent to the front office for phone calls to parents
