**Title I** provides schools with additional academic support and learning opportunities for students at schools that have higher percentages of socioeconomically disadvantaged children.

**Title II** is to increase student achievement consistent with the challenging State academic Standards; improve the quality & effectiveness of teachers, principals, & other school leaders; & provide low-income & minority students greater access to effective teachers, principals, & other school leaders.

**Title III** is to improve the education of English learners by assisting the children learn English & meet the challenging State academic standards.

**Title IV is to:** 1. Provide all students access to a well-rounded education. 2. Improve school conditions for student learning (safe & healthy students). 3. Improve the use of technology to improve the academic outcomes & digital literacy of students

- Judson ISD has 23 Title I Campuses: Kirby MS, Metzger MS, Woodlake Hills MS, and all 20 elementary schools. We also provide Equitable Services through a Shared Service Agreement with Region 20 to regional Private Non-Profit Schools.

- Safety-Security Hall Monitors at High Schools



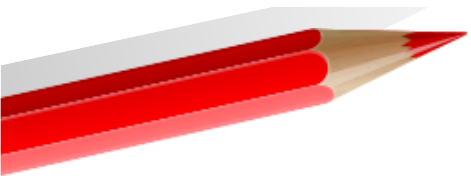
