- Grade Point Average
- 90-100 A 4 points
- 89-80 B 3 points
- 79-75 C 2 points
- 74-70 D 1 point

- How many Bs do you have?
- How many Cs do you have?
- How many Ds do you have?
- Add up your points and divide by the number of classes (in your case, 7...don't count advisory)

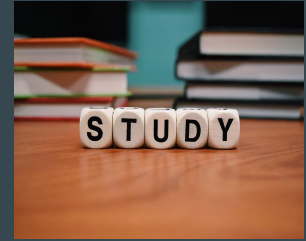
RTI and Schedule Changes
