Open Forum:

Metzger Middle School is implementing a pilot program “Taking a Stand” Understanding your differences. This is a great idea for all middle schools. This will be discussed with Secondary principals at RPM meeting.
- Committee “Judson Pride” is being formed to educate community on what is available education wise in JISD.
- E2020 still in place. The Curriculum and Instruction Department is working with the company to make sure it is “aligned”. It is not recommended that students take the shortened version of the course. If a student needs help in a certain area students can go to site for tutoring. Could be a great tool for students to make up an area.
- Currently looking at an intervention grant for K-12. Identify safe websites for bullying. Students are bullying teachers that don't know how to stand up for themselves and have poor classroom management. How do you teach the teacher to not be a bystander?
